Gamma Pi Chapter, Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., requests your assistance in their Annual Talent Hunt Demonstration. The Talent Hunt Demonstration is on **Saturday, March 14, 2015, at 4:00 p.m.**, in the auditorium of the Charles H. Flowers Senior High School, 10001 Ardwick-Ardmore Road, Springdale, Maryland, 20774.

The purpose of this nationwide program is to offer community recognition to the exceptional high school students in Prince George's County. Participation in this Talent Hunt Demonstration is open to students in grades 9-12 with abilities in the creative and performing arts. Vocalists are required to provide their own accompanist and dancers must furnish their own compact discs (CDs).

Featured will be solo performances in the following areas:

- Instrumental Music (classical or contemporary (jazz, gospel, and pop)
- Vocal Music (classical or contemporary (jazz, gospel, and pop)
- Dance (ballet, creative/modern, tap)
- Visual Arts (painting, drawing, photography)

Contestants performing in the vocal, dance, and dramatic areas are limited to four-minute performances, while instrumentalists are limited to six-minute performances. All music or dramatic selections should be memorized (required at the District and National levels). Performances not memorized will be penalized. In art, a contestant may submit more than two entries; all paintings, drawings, etchings, etc., must be clearly labeled and matted with the student's name.

Cash prizes and trophies will be awarded to the first, second, and third place winners in each category. The overall winner in performance and art will be considered to represent Gamma Pi Chapter and Prince George's County at the District Talent Hunt Demonstration in Teaneck, New Jersey, tentatively scheduled for May 2, 2015. At this event, the winners of similar talent demonstrations held in New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Delaware, and Maryland would compete for greater recognition and awards.

The Gamma Pi Talent Hunt auditions are *Wednesday, February 11, 2015, from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m.* in the auditorium of the Charles H. Flowers Senior High School. We would appreciate your endorsement and support of this effort by encouraging your students to submit an entry form to participate. **February 7, 2015, is the extended deadline for applications.** Please **call me ASAP**, if you have any questions. Feel free to reproduce the documents. Furthermore, we invite you and your student body, members, and representatives, etc., to attend our free Talent Hunt Demonstration to help encourage our youth of tomorrow as they display their talents.
